

Youth and Children's Ministry Coordinator

Job Description

Duties & Responsibilities:

- 1. Coordinate and supervise church school programming Sunday mornings and Friday evening youth groups.
- 2. Integrate children and youth into the broader life of the church as a bridge builder between age groups, the church and the community of Aurora.
- 3. Recruit and empower lay people and equip and mentor leadership skills in Christian service.
- 4. Grow our existing senior youth program to foster the development of maturing, Christian, global citizens.
- 5. Attend optional youth ministry training, formation and networking events as desired.
- 6. Be available for occasional evening leadership meetings and attend all holy festivals.

Skills / Qualifications:

- 1. Post-secondary training or equivalent with some formal theological studies.
- 2. Able to work effectively within a mainline Anglican spiritual ethos, affirming all people regardless of race, colour, socio-economic status, gender and sexuality.
- 3. Working knowledge of child development and youth culture.
- 4. Experience working with children and teens in a Christian setting.
- 5. Able to articulate and model a maturing personal Christian faith.

- 6. Passionate about building a caring community and willing to network effectively with other churches, agencies, faith groups, diverse backgrounds and special needs.
- 7. Strong interpersonal, communication, and listening skills.
- 8. Strong computer and social networking skills will be an asset.

The Youth and Children's Ministry Coordinator will minister according to established policies, practices and guidelines of the Anglican Diocese of Toronto and Trinity Church Aurora. The Youth and Children's Ministry Coordinator will function within a pastoral team.
